 - To work cooperatively with all Girls Academy staff and to maintain relationships with the player's parents or their guardians.
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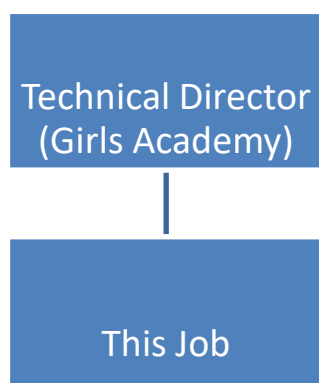
